

Overview


Exhibits can be uploaded as digital evidence to Case Center from an email or text message. The text or email will contain the sender's name, the case name, and a direct link to the case to upload files. The message will also contain the date and time the link will expire.

Upload Exhibits from a Request

- 1. From the device that contains evidence, click on the **link** in the text message or email received from the court.
 - Email Link:

NOTE: If necessary, take pictures of materials for upload using a cell phone.


- 2. From the Upload your documents screen, under Select files:
 - a. To browse for the files on the device, click Add Files.
 - b. Drag and drop files into the **Select files** window.

c. Once all evidence is displayed, click **Start Upload**. **IMPORTANT: Do not select the Restricted box**.



IMPORTANT: Do not leave the page until the bottom status bar reads 100%.

<u>Uploading Exhibits from Android Cell Phone</u>

Rename Photos or Videos Before Uploading

To rename photos or videos on an Android device, use a file manager app, like Files by Google or use your phone's built-in file manager.

Using the Files by Google app:

- 1. Open the Files by Google app.
- 2. Navigate to the folder containing the photo or video to rename.
- 3. Long-press the file to **select** it.
- 4. Tap the **More** icon (Usually three dots.)
- 5 Select **rename**
- 6. Enter the **new name**.
- 7. Tap **OK**.

Using the phones File Manager (often called "File Manager", "My Files" or "Files".)

- 1. Navigate to the folder containing the photo or video.
- 2. Long-press the file to **select** it.
- 3. Tap the **More** icon (usually three dots).
- 4. Select rename.
- 5. Enter the new name.
- 6. Tap **OK** or **Done**.

Save a String of Messages as One Document

Upload Documents from a Request

Android phones can save a string of text messages as one document to send to the court. To do so, take a full-page screenshot and save it to the gallery on the phone prior to upload. To upload, Android users must select the media-picker option to select the files to upload.

- 1. Open the string of text messages.
- 2. Simultaneously press the power and volume down buttons to take a screenshot *or* swipe your hand across the screen from left to right.
- On the Android phone, an additional prompt will pop up. Choose **Media Picker** to select files or photos stored on the device.



Uploading Exhibits from iPhone Cell Phone

Rename Photos or Videos Before Uploading


To rename photos or videos on an iPhone, use your phone's built-in file manager:

- 1. From the *Photo* app, locate the **photo or video** to rename.
- 2. Tap the photo or video to open it.
- 3. Tap the **share icon** (square with an arrow pointing up).
- 4. Scroll down and tap "Save to Files".
- 5. From the *Files* app, select a **folder** to save the photo or video to.
- 6. Tap the current filename (e.g., "IMG_1234.jpg") and **enter the new name**.
- 7. In the upper right corner, tap save.

Expired Link

If the link has expired, request that the link be re-activated.

- 1. Click the **link** from the email or text message.
- 2. From the Upload your documents screen, click New Request.



NOTE: Once New Request is clicked, a message will appear stating the request was sent successfully.
